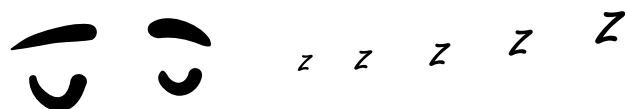

The boring but essential bits...

Liability: Please make sure it is clear that you are fundraising 'in aid of OsNosh CIC' and that your activities are not representing or organised by us. We cannot accept any responsibility for your event or its participants. Please do stay safe, and get help and advice if needed.



Third party data handling: As part of your fundraising you may find yourself handling personal data and information belonging to people involved in your activity. You are responsible for ensuring that any paper or electronic data you hold complies with the Data Protection Act 2018.

As a rule of thumb, keep any data you have stored securely and safe from loss, damage or unauthorised access. Do not keep data for longer than you need it and do not share information about someone without their permission.
